Staff were required to work from home during the covid pandemic, this change was found to be beneficial and a hybrid approach to home-based working been retained. This has resulted in a substantial reduction in emissions in 2021.




### **EMISSIONS REDUCTION TARGETS**

In order to continue our progress to achieving Net Zero, we have adopted the following carbon reduction targets.

We project that carbon emissions will decrease over the next five years to 10 tCO2e by 2026. This is a reduction of 58% from our baseline year.

Progress against these targets can be seen in the graph below:



#### CARBON REDUCTION PROJECTS

#### **Completed Carbon Reduction Initiatives**

The following environmental management measures and projects have been completed or implemented since the 2019 baseline. The carbon emission reduction achieved by these schemes equate to 5.26 tCO2e, a 25% reduction against the 2019 baseline and the measures will be in effect when performing the contract.

- Introduction of hybrid home-based working arrangements for all staff.
- Replacement of traditional office-based customer meetings with remote conferencing alternatives.

#### **Future Initiatives**

In the future we hope to implement further measures such as:

- Consolidating the use of hybrid home-based working arrangements for all staff.
- Support for green commuting (incl. cycling, car sharing and green public transport).
- Consolidation of IT servers (incl. use of virtual servers).
- Support for online participation in user groups.
- Transfer to the use of green energy.
